CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- **ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON SUNDAY 27TH AUG, 9.30 to 11.00am**
- Entries accepted on the day from 7.30am to 9.00am.
- **In situ judging of class 10F – outdoor planter will take place on Sat 26-Sun 27th depending on weather! Please contact Jenny to arrange this. Outdoor planters can be brought to the school by 9.00 on Dalby Day instead.**
- **Pre-entry is required for all photography exhibits by 27th August.**
- All entries must be staged and ready to be judged by 9.15am on the day.
- Floral exhibitors must provide their own vases and trays. It is important if you want these returned to you that you put a sticker on the base with your name on it, that you make this clear when entering the exhibit and, to be sure, that you collect before 4.00pm. Otherwise it will be assumed that we have your permission to sell the item. Paper plates will be provided for other exhibits.
- The show will be open for viewing by the public between 11.00am and 3.30pm. All entries must stay in place until then.
- Trophies to be awarded in the School Hall at approx. 3.30pm.
- Trophies awarded will become the responsibility of the winning exhibitor. It will be their responsibility to care for them and to return all trophies to the committee by July 31st the following year. We would like to ask trophy winners to have them engraved.
- If you wish to collect your entries and or containers please do so between 3.30 and 4.00pm. **Any entries, with their accompanying vases/trays/plates, not collected, or labelled accordingly, by this time may be sold for Old Dalby Day charity funds.**

Love Flowers

- 1F Single T rose
- 2F 3 roses of same variety
- 3F Single gladioli flower spike
- 4F Single large flowered dahlia
- 5F 3 stems of small flowered dahlia
- 6F 6 sweet peas
- 7F 3 flower heads of the same variety, on stems
- 8F Jam jar of garden flowers
- 9F Cactus or succulent
- 10F Outdoor planted display - inc: bonsai, topiary, floral, succulents.
Bring on the day or pre-enter for judging in situ on Aug 26th.
- 11F Miniature arrangement – no more than 10cm (4”) in any dimension.

Love Fruit and Vegetables

- 1V 3 potatoes of same type
- 2V 3 carrots with 15cm foliage
- 3V 3 onions of same type
- 4V 3 garlic bulbs – tied
- 5V 3 beetroot with 15cm of foliage
- 6V 3 leeks
- 7V 3 courgettes
- 8V Single pumpkin or squash
- 9V 3 tomatoes with calyx
- 10V 6 cherry tomatoes with calyx
- 11V 6 runner beans
- 12V 6 french beans
- 13V Longest runner bean
- 14V Trophy tray – Any 4 sorts of fruit &/or veg, any no. of each, tray A4 or less)
- 15V Largest marrow/courgette - by weight
- 16V Single cucumber
- 17V 3 peppers or chillies
- 18V Collection of herbs – tied
- 19V Plate of 12 berries with stalks
- 20V 3 eating apples of same, named, variety
- 21V 3 cooking apples of same, named, variety
- 22V Miscellaneous vegetable (anything not in other categories)
- 23V Miscellaneous fruit (anything not in other categories)
- 24V Largest root vegetable (carrot, potato, parsnip etc) - by weight
- 25V 5 stone fruit of 1 variety (eg: cherries, plums)

NOTE: Only 1 entry of each variety will be accepted per class from each entrant.

For example you may submit one entry of Sungold tomatoes and one entry of Gardeners delight tomatoes for class 10V but not two entries of Sungold.

- 3A Single piece of art/craft work - other - sculpture, woodwork, etc

HINTS AND TIPS

Old Dalby Horticulture & Produce show is a fun exhibition for all the family. The following are helpful hints and tips not rules.

If you are unsure about your entry, please enter it anyway, you never know..

- **Read the class description carefully.** Exhibit only what it asks for.
- Arrive early to get your entry staged well before judging time.
- The fresher the exhibit the better; if possible pick it on the day of the show.
- If the class asks for more than one item, try to make sure all items are a uniform size, shape, colour and texture.
- Ensure exhibits are free from marks caused by pests and diseases and bruising.
- Onions – remove minimal amount of outer skins.
- Carrots and Beetroot should have foliage cut to 15cm, no less.
- Tray display of fruit &/or veg – may contain multiples of each item. There must be 4 different items. The tray must be A4 sized or smaller.
- Beans must not show too much development of bean inside, leave stalk attached, they must be crisp.
- Leeks – cut roots to ¼ inch, trim tops.
- Tomatoes and Cherry tomatoes with calyx – the calyx should be fresh and not shrivelled. All tomatoes should be well coloured and ripe, but not over ripe.
- Floral displays – ensure containers are clean, make sure the exhibit is stable and balanced. Outside petals can be removed to improve the look of the exhibited flower.
- Cactus – ensure container is clean & water doesn't leak from the base.
- Photographs must be no larger than A4 (A5 is preferable).
- Photographs should be **unframed** although may be mounted simply, without glass, if necessary.
- Photographs look much, much better if printed on photo paper.

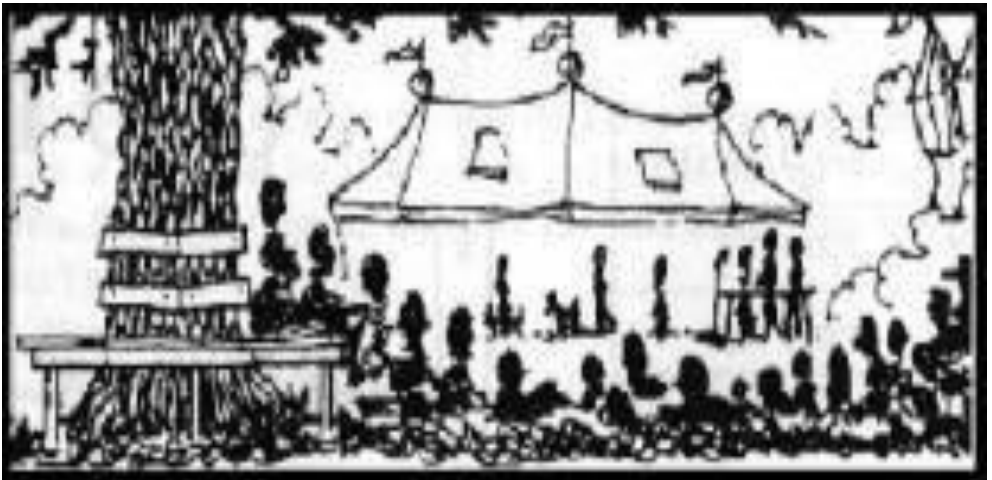
